



## 2011/2012 Tuition Rates and Policies

### Updated Fall Trimester 2011 Trimester

The Great Bay Academy Dance (GBAD) school year is divided into three trimesters. A 13 week fall trimester, a 10 week Winter trimester, and a 10 week Spring trimester. GBAD loosely follows the Portsmouth Public School System calendar, however due to our central location on the ME/NH border GBAD tries to accommodate Maine and New Hampshire scheduling as best we can. ### I: Payment Methods

Great Bay Academy of Dance prefers cash or check, however for your convenience GBAD also accepts Visa & MasterCard credit & debit cards. There will be a 3% service charged to your credit/debit card whenever it is used for payment.

### II: Tuition Fees

Tuition payments are **non-refundable**. In circumstances such as injury or long-term illness (60+ days), school credit will be offered upon written physician documentation. **Credit will not be given for personal circumstance changes in scheduling once a trimester has begun.** School credit is valid for one year after issue and is non-transferable.

Two options\* are available for payment:

- 1) September 11, 2011 for all 33 weeks of class.
- 2) Pay at the beginning of **each** trimester;
  - a. Trimester 1 by **9/10/2011**, or student's first day of class.
  - b. Trimester 2 by **01/2/2012**, or student's first day of class.
  - c. Trimester 3 by **03/2/2012**, or student's first day of class.

\*Students who enroll in the **Ballet Intensive Program** also have the option of monthly payments

Students enrolling in the **Ballet Intensive Program** have the option of paying annually, by the trimester or monthly. When paying monthly, a credit card must be kept on file at the GBAD office, and a \$10 late fee will be assessed to accounts not paid by the 10<sup>th</sup> of the designated pay months.

*Payment Schedule for monthly plan is as follows:*

**Fall Trimester 2011**

September 10<sup>th</sup>, October 10<sup>th</sup>, November 10<sup>th</sup>

**Winter Trimester 2012**

January 10th, February 10th, March 10th

**Spring Trimester 2012**

April 10th, May 10th, June 10th

### III: Programming

Great Bay Academy of Dance strives to provide curriculum, scheduling and payment options that support a broad student base. As a result GBAD offers all-inclusive youth programs, non-all inclusive youth programs and adult programs.

#### **Ballet Intensive Program**

---

The **Ballet Intensive Program** at GBAD is an accelerated program geared towards students that are looking for training at an advanced level. This track includes a focus in learning the fundamentals of ballet, the artistic ability, exciting performance opportunities, the importance of being physically fit, confidence building and teamwork. The curriculum offers multiple classes per week in ballet classes at a designated level. **Ballet Intensive Program** offerings are available for students ages seven and above. Pricing reflects a recommended schedule of classes per week. Exceptions will be made on an extremely limited basis.

## Adult Program

Tuition class cards for adults (ages 18+) are available for the following classes within our adult program.

By purchasing a class card, adult students will receive eleven classes for the price of ten. Class cards are to be used for the registered class only and are valid for one year from date of purchase. No refunds will be issued towards any portion of class cards that have not been used by the end of one year. Class cards are not are not transferable between students.
